



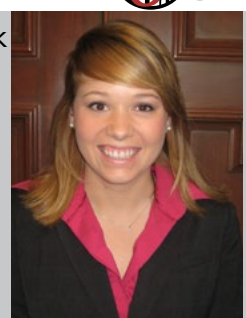

ENTRY REGULATIONS:

- One application per student.
- Each 4-H or FFA group can enter a maximum of 6 students, 4 participants & 2 alternates.
- All applicants must be 14, 15, 16 or 17 years of age as of Jan. 1, 2018 and not beyond their junior year of high school.
- Students may enter multiple years as long as they are eligible.
- 28 Rodeo performances, 28 Calf Scrambles! Jan. 19 - Feb. 3.
16 participants, 8 winners per performance.
- PRIZE: \$500 Calf Scramble Certificate good toward the purchase of a registered Beef or Dairy Heifer to exhibit at the Fort Worth Stock Show the following year, as well as the opportunity to participate in the scholarship program.
- All scramblers receive T-shirts and caps. All students who do not catch a calf will receive a free pair of Justin Boots, courtesy of the Justin Boot Company.
