2019 LIVESTOCK SHOW – GENERAL ENTRY INFORMATION

**PLEASE NOTE ENTRY CLOSING DEADLINE:
ALL ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY MIDNIGHT NOVEMBER 15, 2018**

1. Payment for entry fees and additional passes must be submitted with entries. Any entries received without payment will be returned. Signatures are required on entry application.
 2. Junior entries must be submitted by the respective 4-H or FFA supervisor. All entries from a particular 4-H Club or FFA Chapter must be submitted at one time, with one check or money order covering the cost of all entries.
 3. Please type or print legibly all information required on Entry Applications and Agent/Summary Sheet.
 4. All entries must include appropriate signatures at the time of entry.
 5. Exhibitors with specific stall assignment requests must include request with entries.
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ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH AN AGENT/SUMMARY SHEET. ONE AGENT/SUMMARY SHEET IS REQUIRED FOR EACH RANCH, FARM, FITTING SERVICE, 4-H OR FFA GROUP.

ALL ENTRY INFORMATION MUST BE PROVIDED PER GENERAL RULE 29, PAGE 77 IN THE 2019 LIVESTOCK PREMIUM LIST.

AGENT/SUMMARY SHEET

Required for Open and Junior Show Entries

Information Required: Name of agent (ranch, farm, fitting service, 4-H or FFA group), name of contact, telephone number, mailing address, email address, county, city, state and zip code. All correspondence will be sent to Agent.

OPEN SHOW ENTRY APPLICATION

Information Required for All Open Livestock Entries: Name and hometown of owner(s), name of agent, department number and department name in which animal is to be entered, breed, class number, name of animal, registration number, sex and date of birth of animal, signature and social security number of exhibitor. One entry application must be submitted for each animal in each class.

JUNIOR SHOW ENTRY APPLICATION

FOR THE 2019 JUNIOR BREEDING BEEF HEIFER SHOW

A COPY OF THE ORIGINAL REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE ENTRY APPLICATION AT THE TIME OF ENTRY.

Exhibitor must have original registration certificate for inspection at the Junior Heifer Registration verification on January 25.

All Junior Livestock Exhibitors must be Quality Counts Verified and verification number must be provided on all entry applications when entries are submitted. Entries will not be accepted without Quality Counts verification number.

Information Required for Junior Beef and Dairy Heifers, and Breeding Sheep: Name and hometown of owner, department number and department name in which animal is to be entered, breed, class number, name, registration number, sex and date of birth of animal, signature and social security number of exhibitor, signature of parent/guardian, name of 4-H or FFA Group, CEA or AST signature. One entry application must be submitted for each animal in each class.

Information Required for Junior Lambs, Steers, Barrows and Wether Goats: Name and hometown of owner, department number and department name in which animal is to be entered, signature and social security number of exhibitor, signature of parent/guardian, name of 4-H or FFA Group, CEA or AST signature. One entry application must be submitted for each animal in each class.

Information Required for Junior Agricultural Mechanics: Name of 4-H or FFA group, city, state and 4-H or FFA Tax I.D. number, name of exhibitor (if entry is a group entry submit names of **all** exhibitors), project type and class number and signatures of exhibitor, parent/guardian and CEA/AST. One entry application must be submitted for each project and each class.
